

## UniverSeal - US100 LEED Product Information

UniverSeal US-100 is a single component, polyether based product for use in sealing joints board to board joints on surfaces such as gypsum board sheathing, extruded polystyrene, EPS, fiber-board and plywood construction materials.

It is also used as a liquid term bar with flashing applying it to wood, metal, or concrete.

**Manufacturing Location:** Michigan

**VOC Content:**

- LEED 2.2 for new construction under Section 4.1
- Low Emitting Materials: Adhesives & Sealants
- The VOC content of UniverSeal US-100 is 15.7 g/l which is well below the qualifying level for one credit.

**Recycled Content:** There are no recycled materials used in the manufacturing of UniverSeal US-100.

**Recycled Packaging:** The 28 fluid ounce cartridges are cardboard of which a portion is recycled content so that qualifies for one credit.

**Recyclable Packaging:** The cartridges are packaged 12 to a carton, which is cardboard, and is recyclable. These qualify for Material & Resources Credit 2.1 or 2.2, Construction Waste Management.
